IMPORTANT PUBLIC MEETING FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Intersections in Glendale are getting a makeover. A public meeting will be held 6 to 8 p.m., Thursday, Feb. 15 at Melvin Sine Elementary School (in Library), located at 4932 W. Myrtle Ave. Residents will have an opportunity to learn more about the intersection improvements on 43rd Avenue at Bethany Home Road, Glendale, Northern, Olive and Peoria Avenues and 51st Avenue at Glendale and Peoria.

Current projects include construction of right turn lanes, bus bays with shelters, merge lanes, new streetlights, landscaping, utility relocation and sidewalks.

Information on future projects will also be available. These projects include intersection improvements at 51st Ave at Camelback, Northern and Bell Road, as well as 59th Avenue at Camelback and Bethany Home Roads.

The contractor will be present at the public meeting, along with the design team and city representatives to answer questions about the design and construction schedule.

Glendale voters in 2001 approved a 1/2 cent increase in sales tax to construct major transportation improvements throughout the city of Glendale. Construction began on Glendale Avenue, 67th Avenue, 75th Avenue, and 83rd Avenue in mid-2006. The second phase of the construction is beginning in January 2007. A third phase will occur in late 2007, which will include additional intersections on 51st Avenue, as well as further improvements on 67th Avenue between Olive Avenue and the Arizona Canal Diversion Channel.
