## **TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ON 59<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BEGINS SEPTEMBER 6**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – A traffic restriction just south of the intersection of 59<sup>th</sup> and Northern avenues will begin Tuesday, Sept. 6, due to the replacement of Southwest Gas pipes.

Beginning Sept. 6, construction will commence just south of Northern Avenue through Orangewood Avenue. Once that section is complete, crews will move to the section of 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue, just north of Northern Avenue through Seldon Lane.


Traffic on 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be restricted to two northbound lanes and one southbound lane, and the middle (left-hand turn) lane will be closed in the construction areas. There will be no restrictions for drivers on Northern Avenue.

The contractor will be working between approximately 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., but traffic barricades will remain up 24 hours a day. An off-duty police officer will control the intersection signal lights during construction hours.

The project is estimated to be complete by Nov. 30.
