## **TRAFFIC RESTRICTION AT 59<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND NORTHERN INTERSECTION BEGINS APRIL 11**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – A traffic restriction at the intersection of 59<sup>th</sup> and Northern avenues will begin Monday, April 11, due to the replacement of a Southwest Gas pipe.

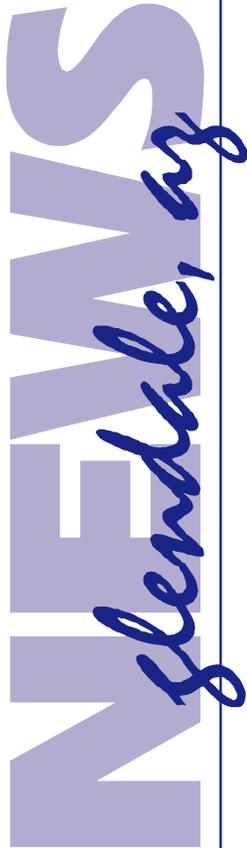
Beginning April 11, construction will commence in the middle of the intersection, closing down the north half of Northern Ave. Traffic on Northern Ave. will be reduced to a single lane in both directions approaching the intersection. Traffic on 59<sup>th</sup> Ave. will be reduced to a single lane heading south and two lanes heading north.

The contractor will be working between approximately 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., but traffic barricades will remain up 24 hours a day. An off-duty police officer will control the intersection signal lights during construction hours.

The first half of the project is scheduled to be complete by April 30, at which point, the work on the south half of Northern Avenue will begin. The project is estimated to be completed by May 20.
