GLENDALE CREATES AGREEMENTS WITH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ROADWAY INSPECTIONS

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The city of Glendale has entered into agreements with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) that will allow Glendale staff to inspect roadway projects within the city of Glendale.

This agreement will be beneficial for both parties; not only will it allow the city to generate revenue from inspection fees from ADOT, it frees up resources for the state agency and provides inspectors on the projects who are very familiar with Glendale roadways.

Currently, the transportation projects being inspected for ADOT are an intersection improvement at 51st and Northern avenues, and a pavement overly project on Bell Road, between 59th and 70th avenues. The city of Glendale is looking to inspect additional ADOT projects in the future.

In addition to providing field inspection services during construction, Glendale is only one of a handful of Valley cities that has an in-house materials testing facility. Concrete and asphalt mix is tested at the city's materials testing laboratory to ensure that the product meets the engineering specifications, and the project is completed in a timely manner.
