CITY ANNOUNCES TWO CLASSES FOR GRADUATES OF GLENDALE UNIVERSITY 101

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Are you a Glendale resident who is a graduate of Glendale University 101 interested in learning more about the inner workings of your city? Be sure to register for one or both of the following upcoming classes.

A two-hour class will teach Glendale residents about the operations of the city's airport, the staff's excellent customer service and how the facility combines the amenities of a big city airport with one-on-one, personalized service.

This course will be held on Tuesday, Oct. 26 from 2-4 p.m. at the Glendale Municipal Airport, 6801 N. Glen Harbor Blvd (approximately 107th and Glendale avenues). Students should park in the lot adjacent to the terminal building and meet in the terminal building. Class participants will learn about the history of the airport, current projects and the master plan. The second hour will consist of a site tour, which will include the air traffic control tower.
