NEW GLENDALE BIKE MAP

GLENDALE, Ariz. – With gas prices soaring over \$3 a gallon, there is no better time to bring out your bicycle and save some money. Glendale has just the answer for you with the introduction of the new bike map.

This free map has descriptions of the city’s newest linear park paths at Skunk Creek, the Thunderbird Paseo and the Grand Canal. It also displays more than 63 miles of on-street bike routes and bike lanes.


The map also provides information on bicycle safety, Arizona bike laws, using bikes on buses and local bicycling clubs and organizations.
