GLENDALE HOLDS UTILITY-ASSISTANCE APPLICATION EVENT MARCH 25

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Glendale’s Community Action Program (CAP) is hosting a low income utility assistance pre-screening on Wednesday, March 25, from 9 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. at the Glendale Civic Center Annex, located at 5750 W. Glenn Dr.


Glendale residents, as well as West Valley residents of Avondale, Buckeye, Gila Bend, Peoria, Tolleson, El Mirage and Wickenburg, are welcome to attend this one -time pre-screening on a first-come, first-served basis. Residents in line at 9 a.m. will be given a number in order of their place in line; however, a number is not a guarantee that you will receive an interview. Residents given numbers that morning may be interviewed over the course of the day and will be pre-screened for utility assistance only.

Applicants should be aware that an interview is not a guarantee of assistance, and should also note that anyone who has received CAP utility assistance in the past 12 months is not eligible for assistance at this time.

Applicants must bring the following documentation to the pre-screening event:

1. U.S. birth certificate or U.S. passport or proof of current legal resident status for ALL household members
2. Social security cards for ALL household members
3. Photo Identification for adult applying
4. Current utility bills (SRP, APS, SWG) - must include meter reading, M-Power printout to show purchases for past 30 days

5. Proof of any money your household received from any source in the last 30 days (including employment, DES, child support, government housing, social security benefits, VA/pension benefits, self-employment, school pell grants/scholarships, and zero income)
6. All adults that are zero income, not receiving any benefits and not working must provide proof of last day worked/paid and amount of final check on company letterhead

In addition, all applicants must meet the Federal Poverty Levels (gross income for the past 30 days). See below for guidelines:
