## **CITY ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

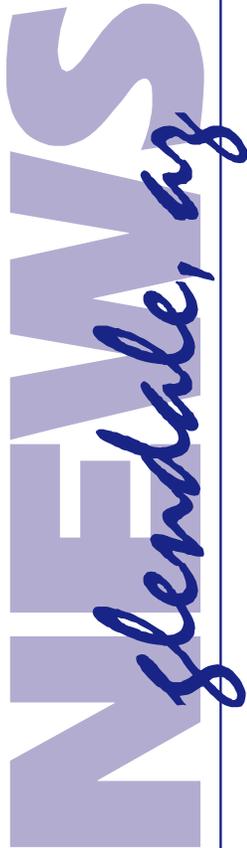
GLENDALE, Ariz. – If you have ever thought about serving on a Glendale citizen advisory group, the Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) might be of interest to you.

The CDAC makes recommendations to the City Council regarding the allocation of federal Community Development Block Grant funds, which help provide affordable housing and other services to low-income residents and create jobs through the expansion and retention of businesses.

The committee also advises the Council on policies relating to the city's community housing and community action programs. Glendale's community housing program is responsible for addressing the rental housing needs of eligible residents who cannot afford housing in the private market, while the community action program helps citizens become self-sufficient while they are experiencing a financial hardship or crisis in their lives.
