GLENDALE COUNCILMEMBER MANNY MARTINEZ HIGHLIGHTS GLENDALE CITY COURT ON “GLENDALE TODAY”

Glendale, Ariz. — Glendale Councilmember Manny Martinez of the Cholla District takes us inside Glendale City Court in his new edition of the TV show “Glendale Today.” Councilmember Martinez’s guest is Judge Elizabeth Finn, who serves as Presiding Judge for the City Court and has 35 years of experience on the bench. Among the topics discussed: the Court’s history, the number and various kinds of civil and criminal cases heard, security, use of language interpreters, warrants, grants and even easy ways for citizens to pay traffic tickets and other court fines online.

Martinez goes along with Judge Finn inside the courtroom for a look at the specialty court services, such as Mental Health Court, Domestic Violence Treatment Court and DUI Review Court. These innovative programs have resulted in cost savings and offer citizens unique ways to handle legal issues. Judge Finn also discusses the prevalence of domestic violence and provides residents resources on where to go for help.
