## IMPORTANT TRAFFIC AND PARKING INFORMATION FOR UPCOMING CARDINALS SEASON

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Football fans need to be aware of changes in the parking plan for 2012 in order to receive the best fan experience possible in the city's Sports & Entertainment District this season.

As in past years, season ticket holders have received parking passes from the Arizona Cardinals with specific parking and traffic instructions. Maps to the assigned parking lots are printed on the back side of parking passes. However, fans should pay special attention to the newly designated parking lots and color-coded sections in and around Westgate City Center. The new colors and the appropriate access points are:

- Purple - access via Glendale Avenue, south on 95<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- Blue – access via Glendale Avenue, south on 93<sup>rd</sup> Avenue
- Yellow – access via Glendale Avenue, south on 91<sup>st</sup> Avenue

Here is additional information that fans need to be aware of this season:

- Pedestrian walkways will be different than in years past. Use sidewalks and crosswalks to ensure the safety of drivers and pedestrians.
- Game day cash parking is available at Westgate City Center and the Renaissance Hotel parking garage. Drivers should access this parking via Glendale Avenue and then south on 95<sup>th</sup> or 93<sup>rd</sup> avenues.
- Parking for single game ticket holders is at the Kellis High School lot, located on the east side of 91<sup>st</sup> Avenue just north of Orangewood Avenue. A free shuttle service will run between the high school and the stadium beginning two hours before game time and ending one hour following the game.
- Parking lots open four hours prior to kick-off. Vehicles will not be permitted to stage on city streets prior to the lots opening.

“We encourage fans to plan ahead and allow enough time to get to the stadium,” said Principal Traffic Engineer Debbie Albert. “For easy reference, a parking map is conveniently printed on the back of all parking passes and is readily viewable when placed on the rear-view mirror.”
