## **COUNCILMEMBER JOYCE CLARK HOSTING DISTRICT MEETING ON MAY 16**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Councilmember Joyce Clark is hosting a community meeting for residents living in the Yucca District at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 16 at Coyote Ridge Elementary School, 7677 W. Bethany Home Rd. The meeting will be held in the school cafeteria.

Glendale Assistant City Manager Horatio Skeete will give a presentation on the city's proposed fiscal year 2012-13 budget, which goes into effect on July 1, 2012. Deputy City Manager Jim Colson will discuss neighborhood revitalization, planning and building activities, and Code Compliance Director Sam McAllen will talk about code enforcement programs.

In addition, Gateway Patrol Division Commander Andre Anderson will provide an update on neighborhood issues, and Police Emergency Management Volunteer Opal Evans will present information on Glendale's Citizen Corps. The corps is a citizen-based organization whose sole focus is to prepare residents for emergencies through community planning and training.
