GLENDALE LIGHTS UP FOR SUMMER SHOPPING FUN

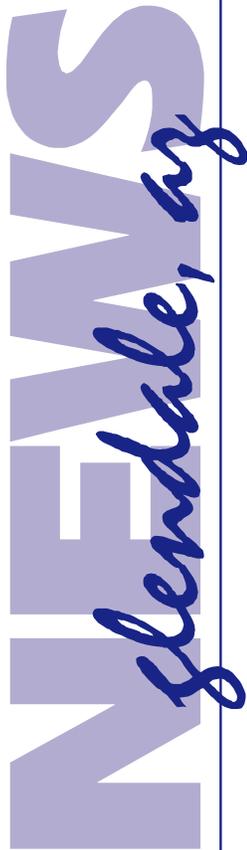
