FOR GLENDALE'S GENERAL ELECTION
This Friday Last Day to Request Early Ballot

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale City Clerk's Office reminds residents Glendale's General Election is Tuesday November 2 and this Friday, October 22 is the last day to request an early ballot by mail or telephone. The General Election includes city council seats in two districts: Barrel and Ocotillo. During the Primary Election in August, none of the city council candidates in those districts received 50 percent plus one of the votes necessary to be elected.
