MLB CACTI LANDS AT WESTGATE IN GLENDALE, FANS CAN WIN TICKETS TO ALL STAR GAME

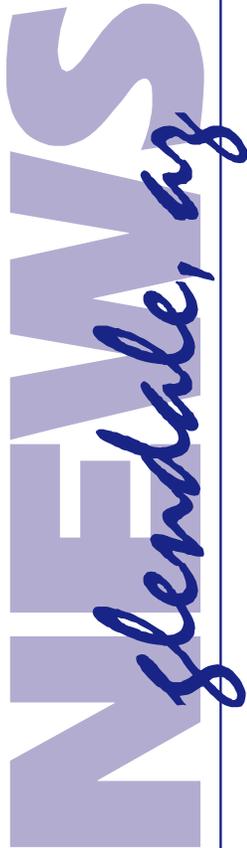
GLENDALE, Ariz. – Westgate City Center in Glendale is the new home to one of the 10 “Cacti on Parade,” a promotion for the 2011 MLB All-Star Game and festivities taking place July 8-12 in the Valley. These seven-and-a-half-foot-tall cactus statues weigh 700 pounds, and are designed with colorful graphics celebrating the All-Star Game, the Arizona Diamondbacks or the American and National Leagues.

The cacti was installed Tuesday, June 7 at Westgate City Center, located in the south end of the shopping center, in the Water Dance Plaza. Westgate’s location is the only statue to be located in the West Valley.

Fans will have the opportunity to win a pair of tickets to the 2011 MLB All-Star Game by taking a photograph of themselves with the cacti statue and entering it in Glendale’s contest. A hard copy of the photo must be entered, either in person or by mail to the Glendale Visitor Center, 5800 W. Glenn Dr. Suite 140, Glendale, AZ 85301. The Visitor Center is open Monday – Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Along with a copy of the photo, your name, address and phone number must be included for your entry.
