MONSOON SAFETY TV SHOW FEATURED ON GLENDALE 11 TV

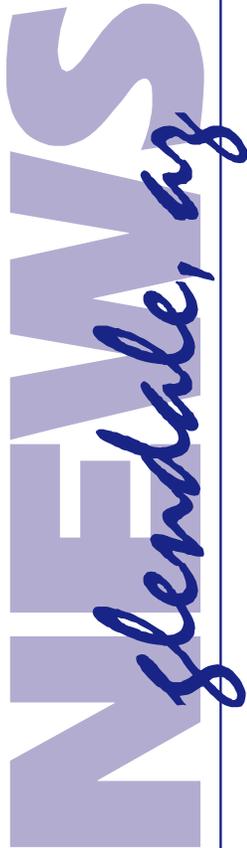
