2007 SPECIAL ELECTION SET FOR SEPTEMBER 11

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Glendale city council members have adopted a resolution directing staff to move forward with a Special Election, which will be held September 11, 2007.


Voters will vote for or against a dedicated public safety tax increase. The proposed increase would be four-tenths of one percent (.4%) on all sales except sales of food for home consumption. This equates to an additional 4 cents on every \$10.

Glendale's public safety tax was first created in 1994 and it has not been changed in more than 13 years. The existing public safety tax is set at one-tenth of one cent.

If passed, the funding would be used only for the police and fire departments. Additional personnel and equipment would be added to these departments if the increase is approved.
