ROCK & ROLL PAINT-A-THON SEEKS APPLICANTS, VOLUNTEERS TO PAINT HOMES THIS FALL

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Do you own a single family home, but due to age or physical impairments are unable to get it painted?

If so, the Annual Rock & Roll Paint-A-Thon program, held on Saturday, Oct. 27th may be able to help. This program, which matches volunteers with those in need of assistance, helps maintain neighborhoods by painting homes of applicants who are 60 years of age or older and/or have a permanent disability, or veteran homeowners who have limited financial resources and are unable to do the work themselves.

Glendale residents who match the above criteria are encouraged to apply to have their homes painted. Volunteers willing to wield a paint brush are also encouraged to get involved.

Residents willing to paint homes during the event on Saturday, Oct. 27 should form a team of volunteers consisting of 15 to 25 people. Volunteers from families, businesses, churches, schools, social service and civic groups can participate in the program. All volunteers must be at least 14 years old and those under 18 must have a signed parent-permission form.

It is expected that teams of volunteers will paint more than 150 homes across the Valley. Single-family, single-story, or mobile homes that are owner-occupied will be painted. Homes must be in sufficient condition that scraping and spot priming are the only preparations needed.
