**RESIDENTS' INPUT SOUGHT ON GLENDALE'S ONBOARD
TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM**

GLENDALE, Ariz. -- Residents are invited to attend two upcoming events to get an update on transportation projects included in the Glendale Onboard (GO) Transportation Program.


These opportunities will give residents a chance to speak with Glendale transportation representatives, learn more about current and upcoming transportation projects the city has planned, and provide input on the program.

The first event is a Transportation Fair held in conjunction with the Glendale Family Bike Ride on Sunday, April 22nd. The Transportation Fair will take place from 7 to 11 am at the Sahuaro Ranch Park soccer field, 59th Avenue and Mountain View Road.

The second event is the 6th annual GO Program open house, which will be held from 4:30 to 7:30 pm, Wednesday May 2nd at the Glendale Civic Center, 57th Avenue and Glenn Drive. Both events will be an open house format, allowing the public to attend at their convenience.

Just over five years ago Glendale voters approved Proposition 402, which dedicated a half-cent sales tax for transportation improvements and created the city's GO Transportation Program. Several of the projects funded through the GO Transportation Program will be highlighted in the 2007 annual brochure, soon to be received by Glendale residents.
