GLENDALE UNIVERSITY

Applications for the Spring 2008 semester of Glendale University (GU) "101" are now being accepted. This free educational program is open to Glendale residents who are 16 or older and want to learn more about the operations of municipal government. GU classes will be on Monday evenings from 6 to 8:30 p.m. The course begins on March 3 and ends May 5, 2008. Each class highlights key functions of the city including, but not limited to finance, library, police and fire services.
