CAMELBACK/67TH AVENUE INTERSECTION CLOSURE BEGINS JANUARY 24 FOR STORM DRAIN PROJECT

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The intersection at Camelback Road and 67th Avenue will be closed beginning Monday, Jan.24 at 3 a.m., for approximately nine days, through Tuesday, Feb. 1. Due to construction for a storm drain improvement project, the entire intersection will be closed in all directions.

During the time of the closure, traffic will have access to residences and businesses, but the intersection will be closed. Businesses near the closure will remain open and accessible.

The project includes installation of a storm drain pipe along Camelback Avenue from 57th to 75 avenues.
