UPCOMING CITY OF GLENDALE HOLIDAY NOTICES

GLENDALE, Ariz. -- City of Glendale offices will be closed for the upcoming holidays: Monday, Dec. 26 for the Christmas holiday, and Monday, Jan. 2 in observance of the New Year’s holiday.

All households’ scheduled garbage and recycling will be shifted one day due to the holidays, from Mondays to Tuesdays, and so on. The Glendale Municipal Landfill will close early on Christmas Eve (Dec. 24) at noon, and will be closed on Dec. 26 and Jan. 2. For more information about the city’s sanitation services, please call 623-930-2660.

Valley Metro buses will run on a Sunday schedule on Dec. 25-26 and Jan. 1-2. The Gus Bus will also operate on a Sunday schedule, with Gus 1 running from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., both Dec. 25-26 and Jan. 1-2. For Dial-a-Ride service for Dec.25 or 26, reservations must be made in advance by noon on Friday, Dec. 23. Dial-a-Ride service for New Year’s Day and Jan. 2 must also be made ahead of time – by noon on Friday, Dec. 30. Reservations can be made by calling Glendale’s Transit Division at 623-930-3500.

While the Glendale Municipal Airport will remain open during these holidays, the airport’s administrative offices will be closed Dec. 26 and Jan. 2. In addition, Glendale’s three public libraries will be closed those days, as well as the Glendale Convention and Visitors Bureau.

Glendale’s Foothills Recreations and Aquatics Center will be open on Christmas Eve from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m., closed on Dec. 25 and open on Dec. 26, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The center will also be open on New Year’s Eve, Dec. 31, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Jan. 1 from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Jan. 2, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. For more information on the Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center, call 623-930-4600.
