GLENDALE, Ariz. – Glendale’s Neighborhood Services Division, in conjunction with Councilmember Jamie Aldama and Councilmember Bart Turner will be hosting the East Catlin Court Neighborhood Volunteer & Information Fair this Saturday, Dec. 5, 8 a.m.-12 p.m.

Volunteer support is needed to assist with several projects to improve this neighborhood. These projects include:

- painting curb addresses
- repainting the fire hydrants
- installing smoke alarms in homes
- cleaning up the right-of ways

The neighborhood fair will close 56th Avenue between State Avenue and Northview, and several city departments - including the Police Department’s Community Action Team and the Fire Department - will be on hand to provide residents with information and resources. The Neighborhood Services’ Tool Lending Program will also be available for residents to borrow tools for various projects in the area.
