**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – The Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center will open its doors in late summer, but Glendale residents who want to get ahead of the game and save some money can pre-purchase a pass at a discounted rate.

The Parks & Recreation Department is offering Glendale residents a 10 percent discount on the monthly and annual recreation pass rates now through June 30.

The recreation pass includes:

- Use of fitness exercise equipment
- Use of jogging/walking track
- Use of gymnasium (open play hours only; times are subject to change)
- Admission to basic step aerobic classes (classes and times vary; does not include specialty classes)
- Access to activity room and lounge area
- Use of racquetball courts (three total)
- Use of lap pool (during scheduled hours)
- Use of the rock-climbing wall

Other special interest classes or workshops, special events, sports leagues and child care are available at an additional cost.

Various types of passes are available, but the discounted rates are applicable to the monthly and annual passes only as a one-time introductory offer. The discount will be taken off the regular rates, listed below. With the 10 percent discount, for example, a monthly adult pass will be \$31.50 rather than \$35.00, now through June 30, 2006. The pass will go in to effect on the date of your first visit to the new center.

**Pass Categories:**

- Non-Prime Time = Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. – 11a.m. and 2 – 4 p.m.
- 2-Person = Any 2 people residing at the same address
- Family = 2 people plus unlimited, unmarried children residing at the same address, 20 years of age or younger
- Group/Corporate = up to 20 employees
