MEETING DATES SET FOR PUBLIC INPUT ON GLENDALE REDISTRICTING

GLENDALE, Ariz. – A series of meetings have been scheduled over the summer for the public to provide input and learn more about how the city of Glendale will approach re-drawing its voting boundaries following the 2010 U.S. Census.

Every ten years when the census is complete, voting districts are reviewed to meet legal requirements which include ensuring all districts have approximately the same number of residents. Growth and shifts in population mean Glendale’s six voting districts will need to be redrawn to meet this standard. Public meetings about Glendale’s redistricting process will be held at 6:30 p.m. on the dates and locations listed below:
