GLENDALE, Ariz. –Dana Tranberg is the city of Glendale’s new intergovernmental relations director.


Tranberg joined the city’s Intergovernmental Relations Office in 2000, and has been acting intergovernmental relations director since the former director left the city in the summer of 2005.
