## GLENDALE “TREECYCLING” SITES

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Glendale residents are encouraged to recycle their live Christmas trees by dropping them off at the following sites. The “treecycling” sites will be open Wednesday, Dec. 26 through Sunday, Jan. 13.

- Acoma Park, 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Acoma Road
- Fire Station #156, 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Deer Valley Road
- Foothills Park, 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Union Hills Drive
- O’Neil Park, 64<sup>th</sup> and Missouri avenues
- Rose Lane Park, 51<sup>st</sup> and Marlette avenues
- Sahuaro Ranch Park, southeast corner of 63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Mountain View Road
- Western Area Regional Park, 83<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Bethany Home Road

Trees must be unbagged, and all decorations, tree stands and metal stakes must be removed.
