**PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2008 WATER/SEWER
RATE ADJUSTMENT SET FOR JUNE 24**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The city of Glendale is hosting a public hearing to discuss the water and sewer rate adjustments planned for October 2008. The hearing is scheduled for 7 p.m., Tuesday, June 24 at a Glendale council meeting.

With the proposed rate adjustment, the average single-family customer, which uses 12,500 gallons of water per month, will see an increase of \$3.01. The average single-family sewer customer, with usage of 7,400 gallons per month, will see an increase of about \$3.20. In comparison to other Valley cities, Glendale rates will continue to fall in the middle range.


The recommended rate adjustments are necessary to ensure that the city has the financial resources to continue to provide the highest quality water and sewer services to Glendale residents and remain in compliance with federal and state regulations.

Some of the Utilities projects currently underway include water treatment plant improvements, replacement of aging pipes in the water distribution and sewer collection system, construction of sewer/odor control stations and improvements to security at water and wastewater facilities.
