**COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION DIVISION PRESENTS
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR PUBLIC REVIEW**

GLENDALE, Ariz. -- Glendale's Community Revitalization Division announces that their draft fiscal year 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan is available for public review and comment through March 25, 2008.

This document illustrates the actions that Glendale proposes to take to address identified community needs through the administration of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and American Dream Downpayment Initiative (ADDI) programs.

During FY 2008-2009, Glendale anticipates receiving an allocation of approximately \$2,957,719 of CDBG, ESG, HOME and ADDI funds to provide citizens with quality housing, assisting in the revitalization of neighborhoods and helping to improve the quality life of residents in need our services. A description of each proposed activity, along with estimated funding and goals, is provided in the draft fiscal year 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan, which is available for public review at the following locations:


