## **NEW GLENDALE 11 TV SHOW FEATURES COUNCILMEMBER DISCUSSING SENSITIVE TOPIC AFFECTING YOUNG GIRLS**

**Glendale, Ariz.** — The sensitive, yet important topic of child prostitution is featured on Councilmember Phil Lieberman’s new edition of the TV show, Glendale Today. During the 30-minute show, Lieberman talks with experts from the Glendale Family Advocacy Center and Soroptimist International of the Kachinas, an international group whose mission is to improve the lives of girls and women.

Lieberman’s guests from Soroptimist discuss the group’s awareness and advocacy campaign to fight Domestic Minor Sexual Trafficking (DMST), including a billboard located at 83<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Glendale. A victim assistance caseworker from the Glendale Family Advocacy Center discusses services provided to the victims including the role of the Glendale Police Department and professional assistance such as counseling for the victims.
