OF GLENDALE'S 2008 GAME**


**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Sports enthusiasts are calling the 2012 Super Bowl a sequel to the game played in the city of Glendale in February 2008. And now fans of the New York Giants and New England Patriots can hit the rewind button and watch some of Glendale's most popular TV stories featuring both teams and Super Bowl XLII.

In 2008, more than 90,000 fans traveled to Arizona to be part of Super Bowl festivities as the Giants and Patriots competed for football's top crown. At that time, New York stunned undefeated New England with a 17 – 14 win in what some have called the greatest Super Bowl ever.
