## **CITIZENS INVITED TO LEARN ABOUT PROPOSED BUDGET REDUCTIONS AT COMMUNITY MEETING**

**Glendale, Ariz.** — Glendale residents are invited to attend a public meeting to hear about proposed reductions to the city's General Fund budget. The meeting is Tuesday, Oct. 30 at 6 p.m. at the Rose Lane Recreation Center at 5003 W. Marlette Ave. Residents will hear about the impact of the proposed reductions and have the opportunity to meet with city staff to ask questions and provide comments.
