**RESIDENTS IN THUNDERBIRD ACRES I TO DEDICATE
IMPROVEMENTS MADE WITH NEIGHBORHOOD GRANT**

GLENDALÉ, Ariz. – Neighbors living in Thunderbird Acres I have new driveway aprons that enhance their streetscape and maintain irrigation as the result of a neighborhood grant for \$71, 508.

The Citizen’s Advisory Commission on Neighborhoods awarded the funds to the neighborhood in spring 2008. The grant, coordinated by the Neighborhood Partnership Office, provided for the removal and replacement of their driveway aprons located in the undedicated right-of-way area of their neighborhood.

The neighbors will be recognized for their efforts to improve their neighborhood by Councilmember Steve Frate who will present them with a plaque during a brief dedication ceremony at 6 p.m. Thursday, April 30 at 13245 N. 65th Drive.

Thunderbird Acres I is a registered neighborhood located from Pershing and Sweetwater avenues and between 65th Drive and 67th Avenue. It includes 39 homes that were constructed in 1963.
