WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT BEGINS IN DOWNTOWN GLENDALE JULY 7

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The waterline construction project begins in downtown Glendale on July 7. Area businesses will remain open & accessible during the project. Work between 58th to 51st avenues is scheduled to be complete by the end of October to reduce the impact on Glendale's holiday events in the downtown area.


Waterline replacements will include connecting current water services to the new waterline. These replacements are necessary to maintain the long-term health of the water delivery system. The overall project is expected to be completed in spring of 2009.

Any water service disruption will be minimal, but notification will be provided well in advance for business or residential customers.

The waterline is currently scheduled to be replaced in the following areas:

- Glendale Avenue, from 61st to 43rd avenues
- 59th Avenue, from Glendale Avenue to Lamar Drive
- 57th Drive, from Glendale Avenue to Glenn Drive
- 63rd Avenue, from Glendale to Maryland avenues
- Maryland Avenue, from 63rd to 59th avenues
