IMPORTANT TRAFFIC BCS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

GLENDALE, Ariz. –Tostitos BCS National Championship fans need to be aware of important game day parking and traffic information that will help make the games a success off the field.

Also, regular Loop 101 commuters are being advised of heavy traffic expected on the Loop 101 from Northern Avenue to Camelback all day. It is advised to use an alternative route home.

Whether you have tickets to the game or not, anyone headed to the Glendale Sports and Entertainment District on game day should pre-purchase a parking pass from the Fiesta Bowl by calling 480-350-0911, going online to www.fiestabowl.org or visiting the Ticket office located at 7135 E. Camelback Rd., #190, Scottsdale, AZ, from Monday to Sunday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Public cash parking will only be available in the Blue West, Blue East and Brown Lots with a limited number of spots. The Brown lot is located at the southeast corner of 91st Ave. and Orangewood. A free shuttle service will run between the Brown Lot and the stadium, beginning at 11:30 a.m. The Blue West Lot is located at the southwest corner of 95th Avenue and Glendale Avenue. The Blue East Lot is located at the southeast corner of 93rd Avenue and Glendale Avenue.

There will be minor traffic restrictions at the intersection of 67th Avenue and Glendale Avenue and 67th Avenue and Camelback.

To safely move pedestrians in the area, 95th Avenue west of the stadium and Maryland Avenue between 93rd and 95th Avenues will be closed to vehicle traffic.

The city of Glendale has partnered with ADOT to provide traffic information for these two events. Motorists are encouraged to call **511** for updated traffic information.
