IMPORTANT TRAFFIC INFORMATION FOR U.S/MEXICO SOCCER SHOWDOWN

GLENDALE, Ariz. –Soccer fans need to be aware of important traffic information in advance to help kick off the game experience.

Also, regular Loop 101 commuters are being advised of heavy traffic expected on the Loop 101 from Northern Avenue to Camelback between 4 to 6:30 p.m. It is advised to use an alternative route home.

There are minor traffic restrictions at 67th Ave. and Camelback, 73rd Ave. and Northern Road, 73rd Ave. and Glendale.

To safely move pedestrians in the area, 95th Avenue west of the stadium and Maryland Avenue between 93rd and 95th Avenues will be closed to vehicle traffic.
