## **GLENDALE ANNOUNCES FEDERAL FUNDING PLANS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC REVIEW**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** –Glendale’s Community Revitalization Division

announces that both the FY 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan and the FY 2010-2011 Annual Action Plan are available for public review and comment until Monday, April 26.

A public hearing to adopt the plans is scheduled for 7 p.m. on Tuesday, April 27 in the Council Chambers, Glendale Municipal Office Complex, 5850 W. Glendale Ave.

The Consolidated Plan serves as a roadmap for spending decisions on federal funds used for public services, housing-related projects and facility improvements that benefit low-and-moderate income persons. Once adopted, the plan will cover the time period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2014.

The Annual Action Plan illustrates the actions that Glendale proposes to take to address community needs through the administration of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG), and the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME).

Annually, the Community Revitalization Division receives program funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which support social and human services in Glendale. A description of each proposed activity, along with estimated funding and goals, is provided in the fiscal year 2010-2011 Annual Action Plan, which is available for public review at the following locations:
