**SECOND PUBLIC MEETING TO BE HELD  
FOR PARKS & RECREATION PLAN UPDATE**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Glendale residents are being asked to attend the second community workshop to develop the priorities and the future of Glendale’s parks and recreation system.

The department is in the process of updating the existing Parks and Recreation Master Plan. The current master plan was adopted by City Council February 2002 and since that time many changes have occurred within Glendale and the surrounding areas. The master plan identifies community priorities for recreation and park facilities along with outlining a plan of action.

The second public workshop will be held from 6:30-8:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 29 at the Glendale Adult Center, 5970 W. Brown St. This second meeting will feature information on the plan and opportunity for attendees to provide feedback on the results of the first community workshop, community focus groups and interviews, online survey and community-wide survey.

Glendale residents’ input during the planning process is critical to help establish priorities for current and future parks and recreation services, programs and facilities offered within Glendale.
