**PUBLIC INPUT NEEDED FOR
PARKS & RECREATION PLAN**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Glendale residents are being asked to attend a community workshop to affect the future of Glendale’s parks and recreation system.

The department is in the process of updating the existing Parks and Recreation Master Plan. The current master plan was adopted by City Council February 2002 and since that time many changes have occurred within Glendale and the surrounding areas. The master plan identifies community priorities for recreation and park facilities along with outlining a plan of action.

The first public workshop will be held from 6:30-8:30 p.m., Thursday, April 29 at the Glendale Main Library auditorium, 5959 W. Brown St.
