ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION SET FOR APRIL

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale Sanitation Division makes it easy for residents to safely dispose of unwanted household hazardous waste with its annual home collection service Monday, April 10 to Friday, April 28.


The first 750 residents can sign-up for the service by calling the Sanitation Division. Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Hazardous materials that will be accepted include paints and stains, antifreeze and other automotive fluids, pesticides, motor oil and filters, batteries, pool chemicals and household cleaners. Items that are unacceptable are explosives, radioactive materials, tires, drums, ammunition and medical or business wastes.

There is a 20-gallon limit on paint, oil, gasoline, antifreeze and other automotive liquids. No single container may be larger than 5-gallons. All items should be in their original containers and must be clearly marked to identify their contents.

To arrange a pickup of hazardous waste materials, residents can call the Sanitation Division at (623) 930-2660. The deadline to schedule a collection is Friday, April 7.
