## TOURS OF SAHUARO RANCH HISTORIC AREA PROVIDE GLIMPSE OF AREA'S PAST

**Glendale, Ariz.** — Two free tours at the Sahuaro Ranch Park Historic Area offer an insight into the way people lived and worked in the late 1800s in Glendale.

Listed on the National Register of Historical Places and known as the “Showplace of the Valley,” the Sahuaro Ranch Park Historic Area is offering a historic 1895 Main House tour from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday and from 1 to 4 p.m. on Sunday, April 15. The 1895 Main House tour features the house interior decorated and furnished with items from the era.

In addition, a ranch site tour is available at 11 a.m., Friday, April 13 and Saturday, April 14. The ranch site tour highlights the ranch’s various buildings, barnyard, historic trees and groves on the 17 acres.
