SHOT SPOTTER COMMUNITY AWARENESS PROJECT

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale Police Department along with the Phoenix Police Department, United States Attorney’s Office and Arizonans for Gun Safety will be working together to provide a safe holiday by educating the public of the dangers of shooting guns in the air and the consequences of being caught.

Door hangers will be passed out in Glendale neighborhoods on Friday December 29th, 2006 between 8am and 1pm explaining the Shot Spotter program to the citizens.

Shot Spotter pinpoints the exact address where a gunshot has been fired 24-hours a day 7-days a week.
