GLENDALE, Ariz. – Are you aware that housing discrimination is illegal?

To learn more about the housing rights afforded to you by federal law, make plans to attend a free seminar on “Confronting Housing Discrimination.” Community Legal Services will present two seminars in cooperation with Glendale’s Community Revitalization Division.

The first seminar, a “Guide for Homebuyers and Renters,” will be offered at 3 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 18, at the Glendale Office of Community Legal Services, 6010 W. Northern Ave.

The second seminar, a “Guide for Realtors and Landlords,” will be offered at 10 a.m. Friday, Oct. 27, at the Glendale Office of the West Maricopa Board of Realtors, 5830 W. Palmdale Ave.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) estimates that more than two million instances of housing discrimination occur nationally each year, but less than one percent are reported.
